Dear President Trump and Vice President Vance,

We, the undersigned members of the Indiana General Assembly, write to you as dedicated representatives of our constituents who share your administration's commitment to pro-life values. We fully align with the recent letter from 51 republican U.S. Senators, led by Senator Lindsey Graham, urging the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to reevaluate and restrict access to the abortion drug mifepristone and its generic versions. Your leadership in restoring protections for the unborn and upholding states' rights has been a beacon of hope, and we call on you to direct HHS Secretary Robert F. Kennedy Jr. and FDA Commissioner Dr. Martin Makary to take immediate, decisive action to address this critical issue.

We commend Secretary Kennedy and Commissioner Makary for their acknowledgement of the discrepancies in the safety data surrounding mifepristone and their commitment to a rigorous scientific review. Recent studies have confirmed the grave risks this drug poses, including severe health complications for women such as hemorrhage, infection, and even death. Mifepristone is not a safe medication; it ends the lives of unborn children and endangers the health of expectant mothers. The HHS announcement to review prior Risk Evaluation and Mitigation strategies (REMS) approvals is a crucial step, and we urge your administration to act swiftly to build on this progress.

However, we share the senators' deep concern regarding the FDA's recent approval of a generic version of mifepristone, a decision that appears to contradict the safety reassessment your agencies have prioritized. This approval not only endangers lives but also undermines the states' rights you have championed since the *Dobbs* decision. Indiana has enacted robust pro-life laws to protect the unborn, reflecting the will of our citizens and the sanctity of life. Yet, thousands of dangerous chemical abortion drugs are shipped into our state each month, undermining our legislative victories and eroding federalism. This unrestricted flow of abortion pills, enabled by federal overreach, circumvents Indiana's sovereignty and must be stopped.

We respectfully urge you, Mr. President, and you, Mr. Vice President, to instruct HHS and the FDA to take the following actions:

- Immediately suspend the distribution and approval of mifepristone and all generic versions pending a comprehensive and transparent review of the drug's safety data.
- Reinstate stringent in-person dispensing requirements and other REMS safeguards to protect women from coercion, misinformation, and life-threatening complications.



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- Ensure federal policies respect and enforce state pro-life laws, preventing the interstate shipment of abortion drugs into jurisdictions with protective legislation.

Your administration has a historic opportunity to advance a culture of life by reversing the Biden-era policies that prioritized ideology over safety and science. By acting on the senators' recommendations, you can protect the health of American women, honor the unborn, and uphold the constitutional balance of power between federal and state authorities. As representatives of Indiana, we stand ready to support these efforts and pray for your bold leadership in this critical moment.

Thank you for your unwavering commitment to these principles. We look forward to seeing decisive action that will save lives and restore justice.
